Final Year Capstone Project | University of Dundee | April 2025

Challenge: Redesign hillside cottage in Gardenstown, Scotland for client living with Essential Tremor since childhood. Address narrow doorways, uneven levels, restricted circulation, and daily emotional strain.

Key Design Solutions:

- Merged two semi-detached cottages into unified open-plan home with fluid circulation
- Designed curved glass extension linking both houses, mapping sun path from east to west
- Created stabilizing landing areas, integrated handrails, and ergonomic kitchen design
- Developed tremor-inspired design language translating movement into zigzag forms and custom furniture
- Conducted extensive user research including client interviews and hands-on engagement tasks
- Specified tactile materials (rubber flooring, birch plywood) supporting stability and sensory comfort
- Balanced accessibility requirements with Victorian-inspired warmth and aesthetic quality
